*This workshop will introduce the technique of preparing a white acrylic shape for achieving a proper limbal blend before painting. This workshop will also include a short presentation going over the entirety of fabricating a limbus from start to finish. In order to receive credit\* for the workshop, each individual will need to complete the task of grinding a white shape and attempting to achieve a proper limbal blend. Participants are required to bring with them all of the following materials: 1.) Safety Glasses 2.) White shape with iris button cured inside 3.) Coarse Grinder 4.) Fine Arbor Grinder 5.) Ball Grinder. Dental lathes and hand dremels will be provided as well as limited amounts of extra materials. \* Attendance alone will not be sufficient enough to receive credit for this workshop. Come prepared with all materials required and perform the task of grinding a white shape for a proper limbal blend to receive full credit.*
